PARENT REMINDERS

We ask that parents/families follow the expectations listed below to help your child receive the optimum faith experience in a safe, productive and reverent atmosphere.

MASS As Catholics we are invited and obliged to participate in the Mass every Sunday. It is a commandment, a precept of the Church and a gift from God. Please make every effort to attend Sunday Mass with your children

ATTENDANCE is important for the Religious Education Program. If your child is absent please complete the chapter at home. Please hand in the Chapter Review sheet for the missed class the week your child returns to class.

BE ON TIME Your child needs to be in class from the beginning to the end of the hour. Please do not schedule an activity that will overlap with Religious Education. We only have 23 hours of class time; we need every one of those minutes. Prayer time is an important element in Faith Formation and should not be missed. Children who are late or have to leave early must be signed in/out by an adult with Pat (Large Church) or Jeanne (Small Church). Please do not disturb the catechist while she/he is teaching.

COMMUNICATION Please review what your child is learning in class. Please keep in contact with the catechist and the Religious Education Office regarding the lessons, behavior and expectations. If you have any concerns about the class please call or email the Religious Education Office and speak to the Director Pat Bartoldus.

SAFETY For the safety of the children, children in Levels 2-8 **MUST** be walked into the building. Parents should wait until the catechist has arrived to make sure there is class that day. In all levels 2-9, an adult **MUST** come into the building to pick up the child(ren) **NO CHILD** will be permitted to leave the building without an adult.

RESPECT and REVERENCE is part of our Catholic identity. We expect all students and adults to be respectful of our Church, the teachings presented, all other students and their catechists. If a student cannot or will not follow these expectations we will need to have a meeting with the parents/guardians to find an appropriate solution.

CANCELLED CLASSES If Religious Education classes or activities must be cancelled due to inclement weather please be advised that we will close when Bayport/Blue Point School District is closed.
